AUTOMATING JUSTICE:

Can Artificial Intelligence Increase Women's and Girls' Access to Justice?

Artificial intelligence tools are increasingly used in core governance functions, including in key political and judicial decision-making forums. Such use carries with it broad implications for women's and girls' human rights, including in access to justice. The event will examine how AI tools—from algorithmic risk assessments, predictive policing, automated social-protection systems, and automated case management and other tools—often reproduce and risk entrenching existing gender inequalities.
